Important Information About Summer Day Camp 2021

General

- Our Summer Day Camp will run for 8 weeks, starting on Monday July 5th and end the week of August 21, 2021.
- Weekly rates: Members \$110, Non-Members \$120 (Family discount: Children (siblings) from same family save \$10 per child per week). Week #5 is a 4-day week (Tuesday to Friday, cost Members \$100, Non-Members \$110).
- The Camper to Camp Counselor ratio is 8:2 (this may change based on restrictions).
- We will only be registering 24 Campers per week (this may change based on restrictions).
- Daily swimming will only begin once our Pool is allowed to reopen. Campers will have the option to play in the Splash Pad daily.
- The Camp will be broken into three groups (cohorts). These groups will not interact with each other throughout the week.
- Unfortunately, we are not permitted to have any day trips this Summer.
- All Camp staff will have at least their first dose of the Covid-19 vaccine and their current Standard First Aid & CPR-C.

SAFETY GUIDELINES DURING COVID-19

as per the Ministry of Health Recommendations

Hygiene

- We will be using only equipment made of material that can be cleaned and disinfected or are single use and are disposed of at the end of the day. We will also be increasing the frequency (minimum twice a day) of cleaning and disinfecting objects, equipment and frequently touched items.
- Minimizing the sharing and frequency of touching objects, equipment, surfaces, and other personal items.
- Performing and promoting frequent, proper hand hygiene (including supervising or assisting Campers with hand hygiene) throughout the day as well as before and after eating.
- All Campers and Staff will be required to wear face masks.
- All Campers are asked to bring extra face masks daily in case their mask becomes wet, soiled, or damaged.

Social Distancing

- Maintaining consistent cohorts of 10 (8 campers, 2 staff) throughout each week.
- Practice social distancing (2 metres) as best as possible between Campers & Staff during activities while still permitting interactions and socializing to occur.
- Staggering/alternating outdoor activities to reduce the number of individuals in one area.

- Incorporating more individual activities or activities that encourage more space between Campers.
- Only Campers will be allowed entry to the facility. Parents and/or Guardians will drop-off and pick-up Campers at the entrance to the Club. Campers will be met by their Counselor at the entrance and taken to designated room at the start of the day and at the end of the day the Counselor will escort the Camper to Reception when the Parent/Guardian arrives for pick up.

Screening

- Each Camper will need to submit a Covid-19 screening form daily before being allowed to enter the facility.
- **We have the right to deny entry to any Camper who has any of the symptoms outlined in the COVID-19 Reference Document for Symptoms on the Ministry of Health's COVID-19 website, or who has come in close contact with a person with symptoms of or confirmed COVID-19 in the past 14 days.**
- Alcohol-based hand sanitizer containing at least 60% alcohol content will be placed at all screening stations and throughout the facility.
- Daily records will be kept to indicate anyone (e.g., campers, parent/guardian, staff and visitors) entering the program setting who stays for 15 minutes or longer. These records will be kept up-to-date and available to facilitate contact tracing in the event of a confirmed COVID-19 case or outbreak.
- Campers or staff who have been exposed to a confirmed case of COVID-19 will be excluded from the program setting for 14 days.
- If a Camper begins to experience symptoms of COVID-19 while attending camp, they will be immediately separated from others in a supervised area until they can go home. In addition, where possible, any staff providing care to the camper will be maintaining a distance of at least 2 metres.
- The local public health unit will then be contacted to notify them of a potential case, and we will notify all parties involved.

WHAT YOU WILL NEED TO BRING

- Lunch, snacks and reusable water bottles that are not to be shared with other Campers.
- We will be incorporating a lot of outdoor activities daily, so please make sure to pack your child's sunscreen, water bottle, swimsuit, towel, and hat.
- Campers will need to be able to apply sunscreen themselves, or have it applied prior to arriving at Camp for the day.
- A change of clothes, it is best to be prepared!
- We strongly encourage children to bring their own individual hand sanitizers.
- Campers must label all belongings with their first and last name.
